For the past two-and-one-half years, Lebanon's *Hearing Voices Network* (*HVN*) Support Group grew from a collaborative effort by Lebanon County's Community Support Program (CSP) Committee, the Central Region CSP, the Recovery Opportunity Center, Philhaven, and community volunteers. The support group embraces an alternative approach to coping with voices, visions, and other extreme states that is empowering and does not start from the assumption of chronic illness or brain disease. The support group is held every Saturday from 10 – 11:00 AM in the 1<sup>st</sup>-floor conference room at Halcyon Activity Center, 728 Walnut Street, Lebanon, PA 17042.



Lebanon's HVN Support Group is facilitated and led by people with lived experience.

- The group conducts itself with rules of confidentiality.
- It's a self-help group and not a clinical group offering treatment. Members are not subject to referral, discharge or risk assessment.
- The HVN Support Group focuses primarily on sharing experiences, support and empathy.
- · Members are able to come and go as they want without repercussions.
- Members are aware of the facilitator's limits concerning confidentiality.

A large body of scientific literature provides evidence for key aspects of this approach, and the hundreds of peer-lead support groups in 30 countries on 5 continents are enabling voice hearers – even those who have been chronically disabled – to learn to cope more effectively or to rid themselves of the negative effects of their voices.
